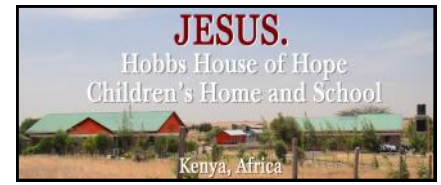

A WORD FROM HOBBS HOUSE OF HOPE KENYA DIRECTOR, PASTOR PETER NJAO

We take this opportunity to thank all those who have continued to support our God-given mission to help the poor and orphans at JHHH. Since the first day we rescued the kids to this day, God has been very faithful in touching people like you to help provide for the children who call Hobbs House of Hope “home.”

Our Need: Our greatest need now is to construct a school building that will serve grades Pre K-8, with each class seating 25-30 kids. The school would also contain a computer lab and library. It has been our prayer that God may provide so that we could build a school with enough classes and better facilities to enhance concentration and learning, creating personalized one to one coaching which will help children to progress towards being educated as great leaders in the society.

Our Goal: It is our goal to educate these children in the school with high impressive academic standards which will be offered in small classes to facilitate teacher-student consultation at all times. This shall be able to produce children with high values--honest, disciplined, spiritual citizens, ready to take responsible roles in the society. With our mentoring program, each one of these kids desiring to become doctors, lawyers, pastors, engineers, and political leaders, can achieve their goals. Only God knows what the future holds.

Our Vision: With good school facilities we will not only be able to educate our children who reside at JHHH, but will also be able to open our doors to the community around us—families who can pay school fees for their children. These tuition fees from “day schoolers” will go a long way in helping JHHH to become self-sufficient and self-sustaining in the near future. JHHH will no doubt be a place from which the kids will be ambassadors when they are excelling in life, to point back and say, “I received my education at JESUS. Hobbs House of Hope School,” just as our Motto states: “Quality Education for Quality Life.”

We therefore invite you to prayerfully consider your role in helping us build and make JHHH a first class school for needy children. 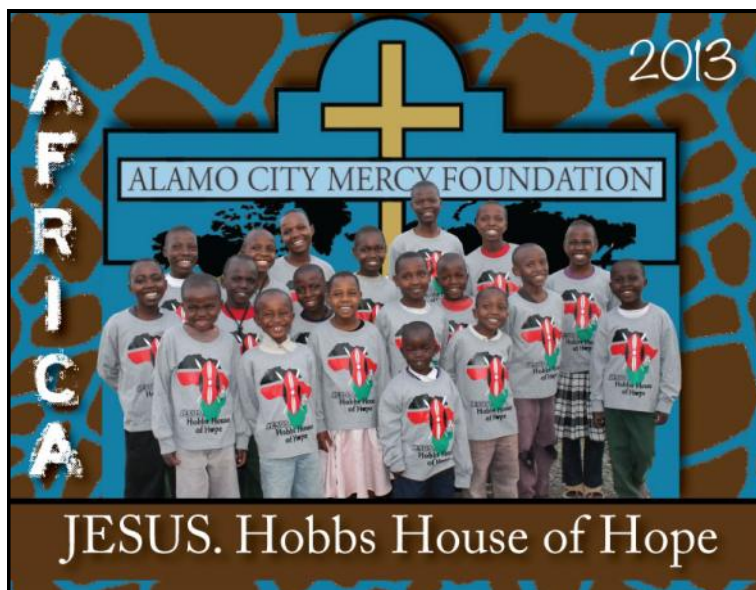
