

UPDATE on the Newsletter below sent out in July from Africa:

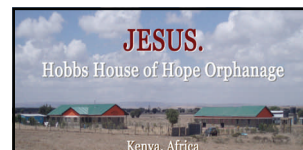

Part of this memorial funding came in the form of a **\$5,000 matching grant** given in hopes that it will be an incentive for people to give. Another provision towards the purchase of land came from the Mission Team from Grace Baptist in Bowie, Maryland who donated the surplus of money left over after their trip to the orphanage.
