

JESUS. HOBBS HOUSE OF HOPE: BUILDING A SCHOOL

God has poured out many blessings on the JESUS. Hobbs House of Hope Children's Home over these past three years in operation. One of those major blessings is an amazing educational system with incredibly gifted and qualified teachers under whom our children have learned and thrived. They are not only receiving an excellent education, but because our school is based on a strong Christian foundation, our kids are also growing in their relationship with Christ. News of the "JESUS. Hobbs School" has spread throughout the district and many parents have approached us requesting that their children be allowed to join our school. We prayed and feel the Lord is leading us to use the resources with which He has blessed us to serve our neighbors by opening our school doors to their children. This will greatly benefit both the community and the House of Hope. Not only will the area children be receiving a top Christian education, but the tuition fees their parents pay to the school will exponentially speed the process of our goal of becoming totally self-sufficient...a 'win-win' for everybody!

Our predicament is that with our 17 orphans and the 10 new 'day-schoolers' we have already received, there is no room for any additional children. (Currently our upper school consists of three rooms separated by wooden partitions, in what was originally intended to serve as our library.)

With this dilemma in mind, Kristi Hobbs met with Architects in Nairobi, Kenya in June to discuss the possibility of constructing a new school building on the grounds. Plans were drawn, costs were given, and now the vision is cast.

We will begin with one floor consisting of 6 classrooms. In time, we will add two more stories which will give us a total of 18 classrooms. Our long term goal is to build another dorm for the purpose of establishing a boarding school which would make us completely self-supportive within one to two years of completion.

We ask that you pray and consider helping fund our new school by giving an End of Year Tax-Deductible Gift. The ground floor totaling 4,210 sq.ft. will cost \$117,000 (\$27.80/sqft) or \$19,000 per classroom. (The cost of the foundation was not included in October's newsletter.) Although this amount seems overwhelming we have seen God provide miraculously thus far and are trusting Him once again to move on the hearts of our supporters. 




PRE-SCHOOL GRADUATION CEREMONY -
